

## Torbreck 'Cuvée Juveniles' Barossa Valley GSM

- This youthful unoaked blend encapsulates all that is great in a pure, unseasoned wine, from the classic Barossa varieties of Grenache, Mataro (Mourvèdre) and Shiraz.
- 61% Grenache, 28% Mataro, 11% Shiraz, sourced from vines between 40–150 years old.
- Ripe, savoury flavors of dark berry fruit and cassis, spiced cherries and succulent blueberry fruit balanced with fresh acidity and a fine, gentle tannin structure.

## d'Arenberg 'The Dead Arm' McLaren Vale Shiraz

- Dead Arm is a vine disease resulting in one 'arm' of the vine slowly being reduced to dead wood, while the grapes on the other side, although low yielding, display amazing intensity.
- 100% McLaren Vale Shiraz
- This iconic wine always displays the power and intensity of McLaren Vale Shiraz. Aromas of boysenberry, sour plum and black peppercorns on the nose, the palate is long and lush with tightly wound tannin and mouth-watering acidity.
