LA CREMA

- Winemaker: Craig McAllister
- Known for: Cool Climate Chardonnay and Pinot Noir
- The wine: Aromas of fresh mandarin with hints of raspberry and guava. Flavors of fresh red berries and watermelon are complemented by undertones of minerality.
- Vine to Bar pairing:

**ALMONDS WITH PINK HIMALAYAN SALT**

The subtle crunch of roasted California almonds enhanced by a light sprinkling of Pink Himalayan salt complements the bright fruit finish of Chardonnay Marc.

HARTFORD COURT

- Winemaker: Jeff Stewart
- Known for: High Risk, High Reward Single Vineyard Wines in Russian River Valley
- The wine: Aromas of black cherry, blueberry, black currant, and allspice are followed by flavors of wild raspberries, and a crushed rock minerality.
- Vine to Bar pairing:

**TART CHERRY AND COCOA NIBS**

The notes of tart cherry paired with the brightness of the Chardonnay Marc mingle beautifully while the topping of cocoa nibs provides a burst of flavor.

MURPHY-GOODE

- Winemaker: Dave Ready, Jr.
- Known for: Sonoma County Pioneers since 1985
- The wine: Soft tannins invite ripe, yet fresh flavors of black raspberry, black cherry, and blackberry jam.
- Vine to Bar pairing:

**DARK CHOCOLATE**

A delicious dark chocolate infused with bright crisp Chardonnay notes, finishing with hints of fruit.

**CHARDONNAY SMOKED SALT AND COCOA NIBS**

Toasted oak notes intermingle with the fruitiness of the Chardonnay Marc and pop of cocoa nibs to create a taste and textural delight.
